

Smart Energy Hackathon - Terms and Conditions

Overview

This Terms & Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the organizers, the location host, sponsors, and the participants. All prior representations, statements, negotiations and undertakings with regard to the subject matter hereof are superseded hereby. If any term or provision of this Agreement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining terms and provisions of this Agreement, or the application of such terms or provisions to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and each term and provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law. These terms and conditions may be subject to change without notice, from time to time in our sole discretion. We will notify confirmed participants of changes conducted via email.

Terms of Participation

Any persons are eligible to participate who are 18 years of age or older.

- 1) In order to register for the event, the participant must apply first at <https://goo.gl/forms/5hqVezt5H9fV4BS52>
- 2) The application deadline for the Smart Energy Hackathon is 11:59 PM August 19, 2018.
- 3) Successful applicants will be announced by 11:59 PM August 22, 2018 and will have till August 31, 2018 to purchase a ticket.
- 4) If the application is accepted, you will be re-directed and given a password to purchase a ticket on the website.
- 5) By purchasing a ticket, you will be agreeing to the Terms and Conditions of the Smart Energy Hackathon outlined below.
- 6) The Smart Energy Hackathon will take place from Friday, September 7 to Sunday, September 9, 2018.
- 7) The team size is restricted to a maximum number of five persons. Should the participants not form a team in advance of the event, the organizers will allocate the individual participants to a team prior to the event.
- 8) Participation in the Smart Energy Hackathon costs \$24 USD for a regular ticket and \$12 USD for a discounted student ticket.

Originality

Each Entry (Submission) must be original, of the Participant's or Participant's team's own creation and must not have been entered in any other competition or program similar to the Hackathon.

Entries may be subject to a due diligence review at any time for eligibility and compliance with these Terms. Participant represents and warrants that the Entry is and will be Participant's or Participant's Teams own original work and does not and will not infringe the intellectual property or proprietary rights of any third party, including, without limitation, any third party patents, copyrights or trademarks. Should third parties nonetheless file a claim for the violation of their rights and should such violation be the result of intentional or grossly negligent conduct of the participant, then the participant shall be liable for any and all damages.

Protection of Intellectual Property

All submissions to the Hackathon remain the intellectual property of the individuals or teams that developed them. By registering, consenting to the terms of the Hackathon, and submitting an Entry, however, the Participant agrees that Entries will be published (including the code) and the organizers and sponsors reserve an irrevocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use, distribute to the public, and publicly display and perform the Submission on an educational, promotional and not-for-profit basis starting on the date of the commencement of the Hackathon (September 8, 2017) as an example of work.

Datasets

Datasets will be made available to participants during the hackathon. However, re-purposing of the datasets after the hackathon is not allowed. Should the participant be interested in doing so, the participant must contact the dataset provider for licensing agreements.

Judging Criteria

The submissions will be judged on the following criteria on a scale from 1 to 5 (5 being the best).

Idea (25%)

How creative and original is the idea to solve a problem in the selected category?

Execution (25%)

Includes how well the idea was designed and implemented, the complexity of the build and creative use of developer tools.

User Experience (25%)

How integrated is the entire design of the program, functionality and visual aesthetics?

Presentation (25%)

How well does the team deliver its prototype, description and value proposition?

Awards

The top four entries with the highest scores will be awarded a cash prize. The cash prizes are:

First Prize - \$4,000 USD

Second prize – \$3,000 USD

Third Prize - \$2,000 USD

People’s Choice Award - \$1,000 USD

The decision of the judges will be final. Pitches from the teams will be from 1:00pm – 5:00pm on Sunday, 10 September 2017

Participants will have the option of being paid in digital currency, USD or Thai Baht.

Refusal of Registration

Organizers may refuse registration for the event without having to state cause and reserves the right to at any time exclude participants from the event who have already been admitted. This applies in particular in cases in which the rules of the game are breached, or if technical means or other manipulative aids are deployed. In such event, the organizers is entitled to revoke the prizes and/or to demand that they be returned, as the case may be. This shall also apply should the users fail to make truthful statements in providing their personal details.

Publicity

By participating in the Hackathon, Participant consent to the use of his/her name, photo, entry for promotional purposes, including without limitation, inclusion in Sponsors’ newsletters, Sponsors’ website, and any of the Sponsors’ social media accounts or outlets without additional compensation.

Participants also consent to their contact addresses being shared with the sponsors for them to contact Participants.

Filming and Photography

There will be a photographer and videographer on-site at the event that may request an interview or statement. The organizers reserve the right to edit, copy, distribute and publicly use the photos and video recordings for promotion.
